The mission of Translators without Borders is to provide people with access to vital knowledge in their language through translation, training of translators, best use of technology, and building translation capacity in underserved languages.

Contract length:4.5 months starting early May 2017, with the possibility of extension **Hours:** Full-time (core hours to correspond to working day in GMT+2) **Location:** Home-based; preferably in a time zone close to GMT+2 **Travel:** in countries affected by the European refugee crisis **Application deadline**: 16 April 2017

Translators without Borders, a US 501(c) 3 non-profit with an operations center in Kenya, was founded in 1993 to provide volunteer translations to non-profit organizations. In 2010, the organization started a virtual platform to better coordinate these resources. In the last five years, we have translated more than 40 million words of life-saving and life-changing content in over 190 languages. Our activations around the Ebola crisis and Nepal earthquake have won widespread praise from the international community.

Background

TWB started to respond to the European refugee crisis in October 2015 and has offered a range of language services to humanitarian agencies since then, in partnership with the Start network and Save the Children and as a member of theDfID-funded Mixed Migration Platform consortium. To date, we have provided translation to partners working in the response; trained partner staff, professional and aspiring translators and interpreters and cultural mediators; set up a translators' and interpreters' working group; and started a humanitarian interpreter roster.

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The Role

The Project Director oversees implementation of TWB's European Refugee Response project, with overall responsibility for timely and effective delivery of activities, efficient and transparent financial management, staff development, and learning.

Responsibilities

- Remotely manage a Project Manager Translations and Project Manager Partnerships in ensuring timely delivery of quality services and professional and productive engagement with partners
- Monitor and manage budgets in compliance with TWB and donor requirements
- Oversee staff development and performance management and promote capacity building and learning across the team
- Work closely with the TWB MEL Manager on executing the M&E plan for the ERR project, ensuring flexibility and innovation are incorporated and embraced
- Proactively seek opportunities to expand the depth and breadth of the project in response to need, and develop funding proposals to that end
- Working with the crisis response management team, lead on planning and resourcing (staff, finance, etc.) for the development of any new areas of intervention
- Maintain open and professional relationships with the internal TWB team, TWB volunteers, partner agencies and donors
- Ensure that management and donors are aware of extensions, budget revisions or substantial changes in the project in a timely manner
- Contribute to a positive, innovative and supportive work environment

Qualifications

The ProjectDirector should be an organized self-starter with strong management credentials, and enthusiastic about the importance of increasing access to knowledge through language. The right candidate is an energetic team player and leader who agrees with TWB's basic beliefs and values and who can work virtually with team members based throughout the world.

Requirements

- 5+ years of project management experience in the humanitarian or development sector
- Humanitarian aid experience preferred
- Interpreting or translation experience a plus, but not essential
- Flexible location
