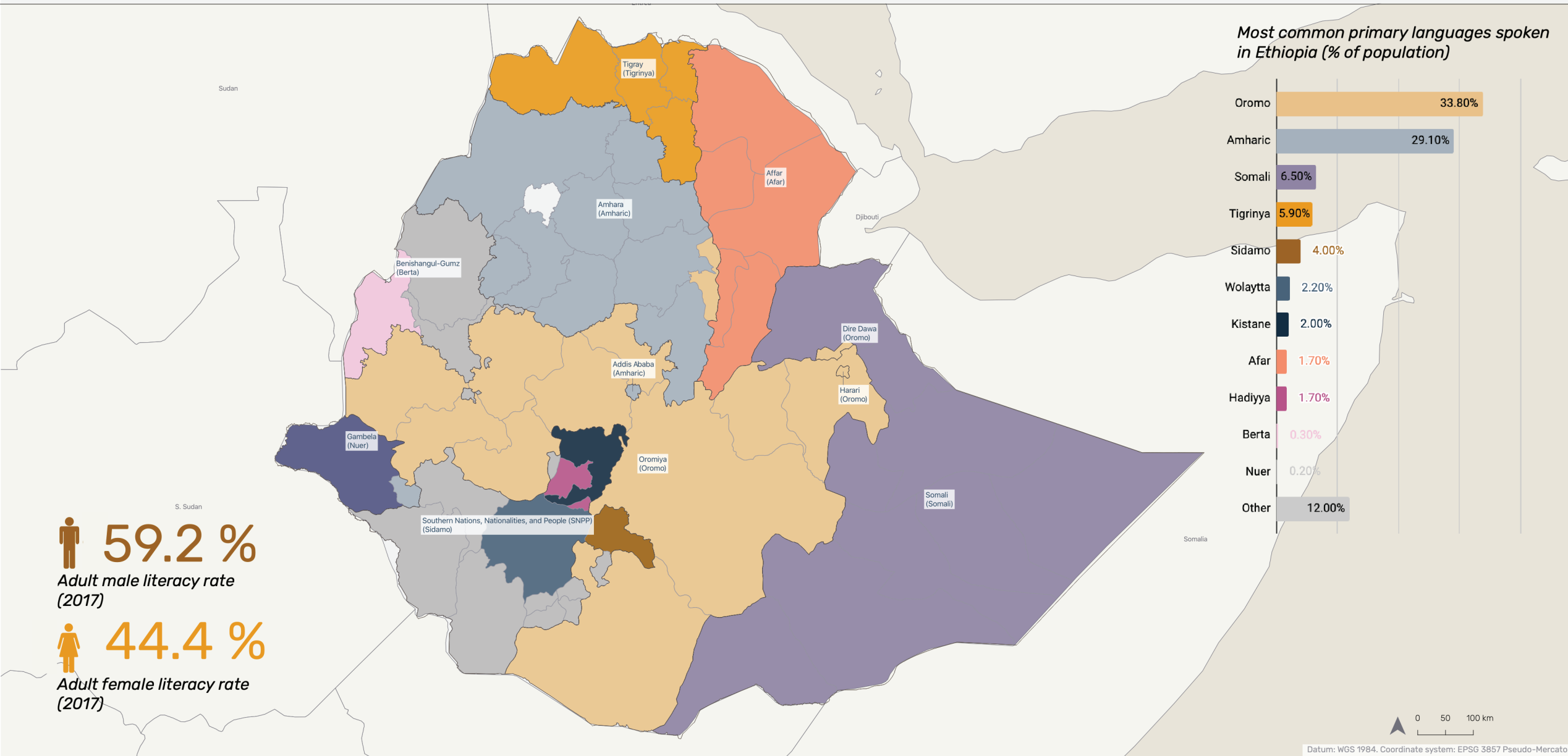


Language map of Ethiopia



Most common primary language



According to the 2007 Census of Ethiopia, the country has 45 major languages. Amharic is the government's official language, and is widely spoken as a first or second language. Oromo is spoken by over a third of the population as their first language and is the most widely spoken primary language in the country. Primary school instruction is given usually in Amharic but also in local languages such as Oromo and Tigrinya in many areas.
