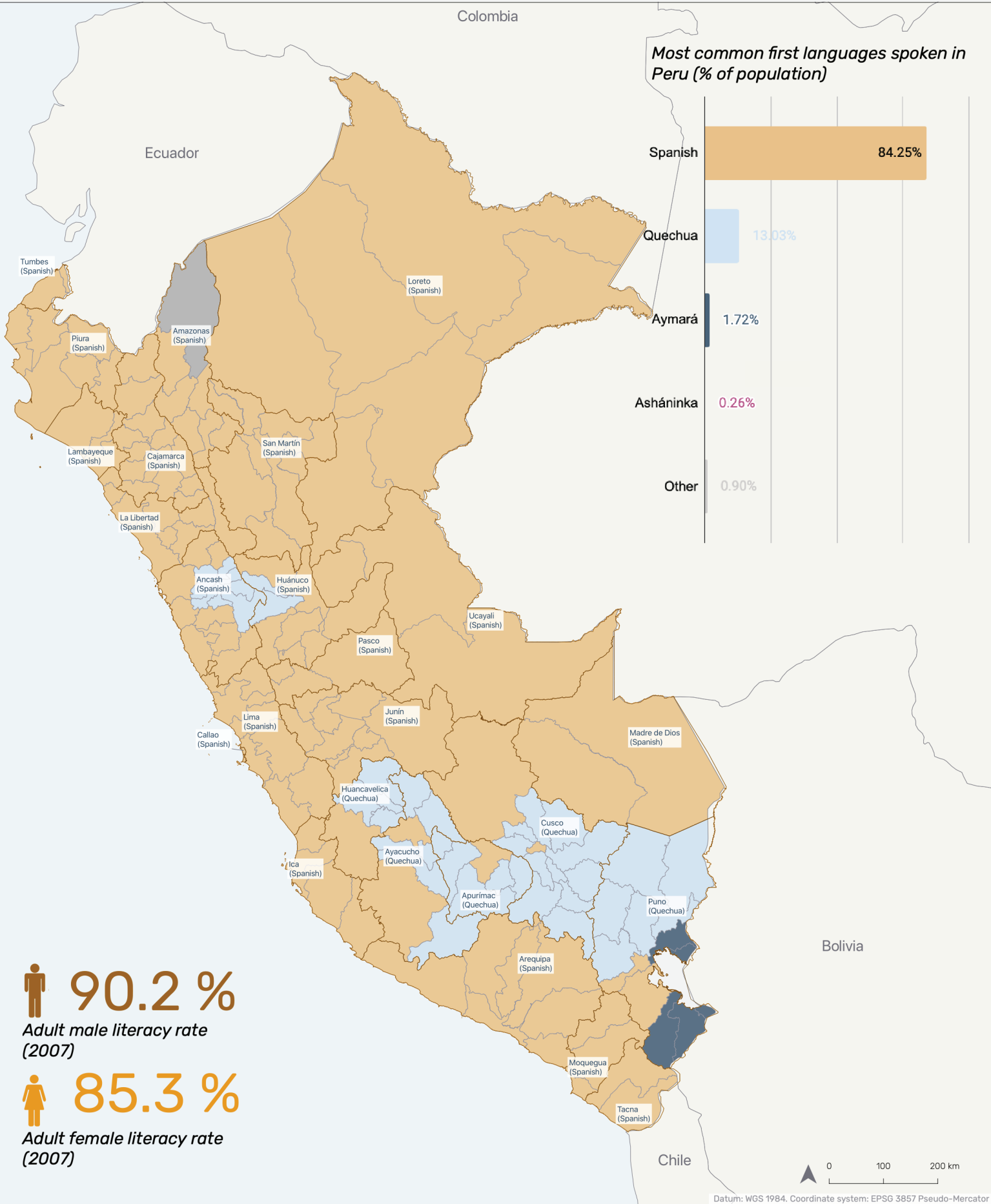


Language map of Peru



Most common first language



The 2007 Census of Peru records just four major languages, although over 72 indigenous languages and dialects are spoken in the country. Three have the status of official languages: Spanish, Quechua, and Aymara. Of these, the census indicates that Spanish is the most widely spoken as a first language (84% of the population), followed by Quechua (13%) and Aymara (2%).
