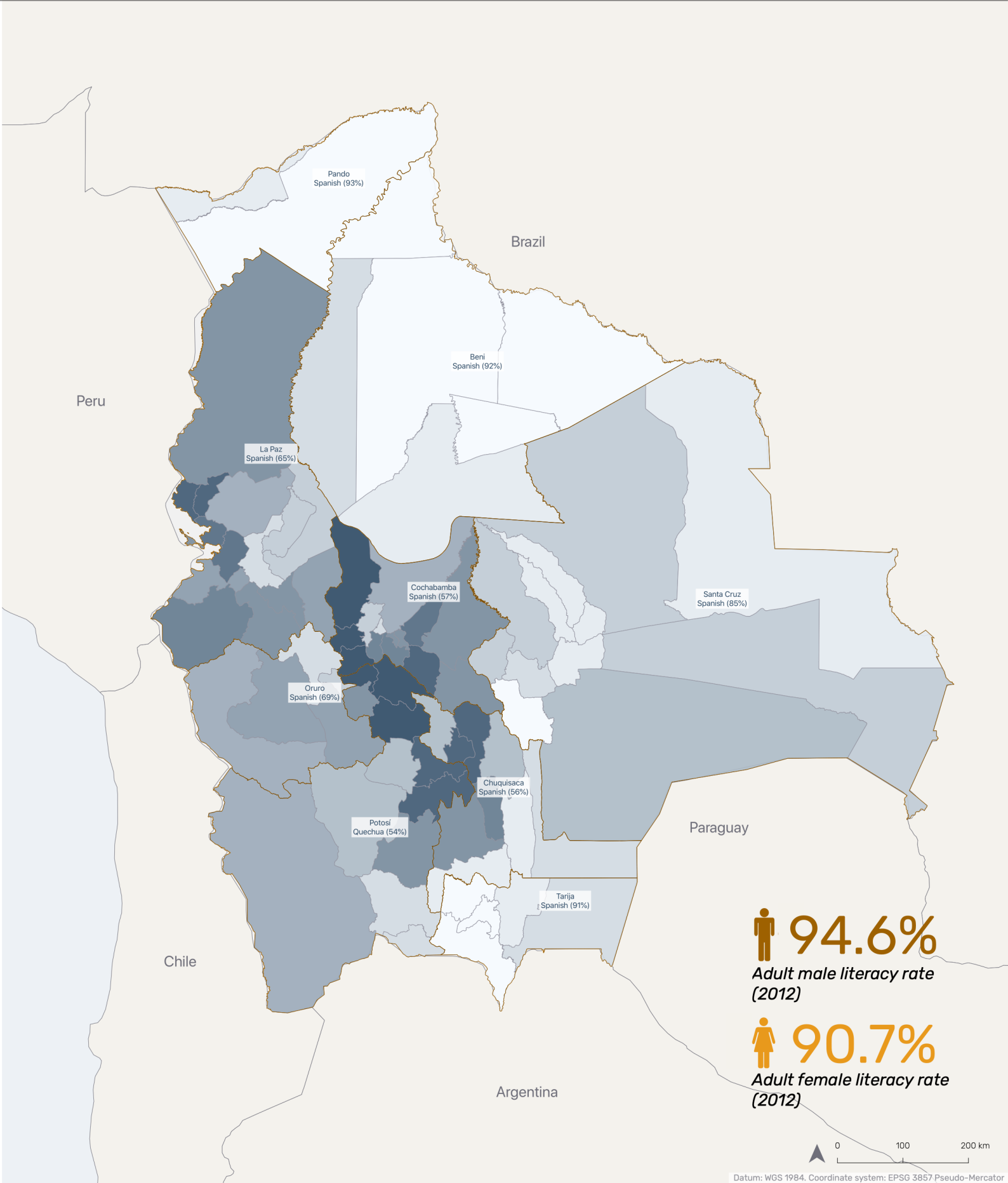




Languages of Bolivia other than Spanish

Spanish is the language of mass media and nearly all written communications in Bolivia. Even so, over 30% of the population speak a different first language. Spanish is less common in areas where Quechua and Aymara are widely used, especially in parts of the Andes and in the Altiplano around Lake Titicaca, in Potosí, Cochabamba and La Paz Provinces.
