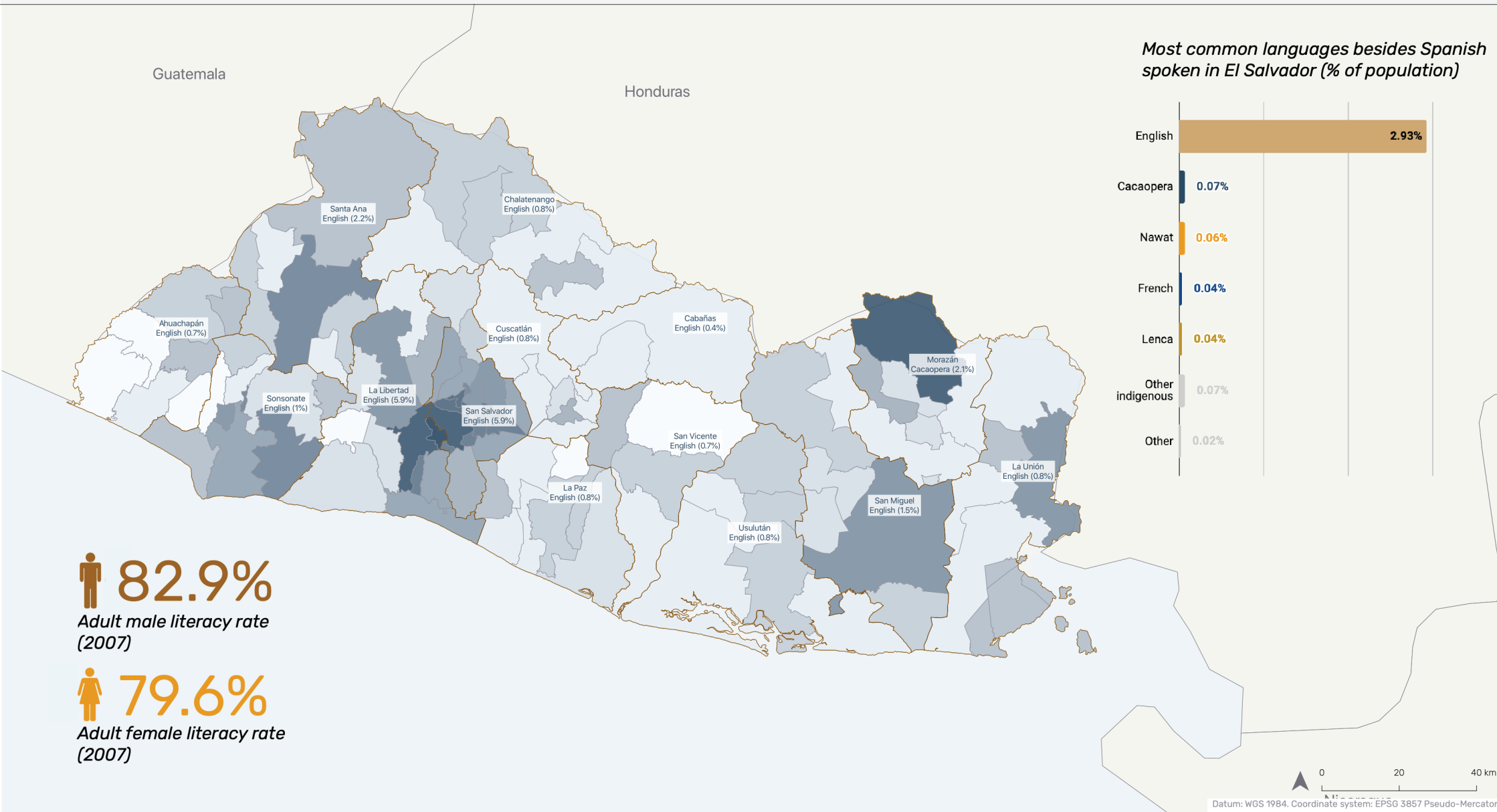


Languages of El Salvador other than Spanish

The 2007 census of El Salvador records 8 main languages spoken in the country besides Spanish. Spanish is the official language and is spoken by virtually all inhabitants. Some Indigenous groups also speak their own languages, such as Cacaopera (spoken by 0.07% of the population according to the census) and Nawat (0.06%).
